**Denisovan Hybrid Cave Yields Four More Hominin Bones:** Last month, a tiny bone fragment belonging to an ancient human hybrid, was found in Denisova Cave.
Researchers have now found four more hominin bones from the same cave. (article)

Traces of the World's First 'Microbrew' Found in a Cave in Israel: At a graveyard cave in Israel, archaeologists discovered traces of mashed wheat and barley lining pits carved into the bedrock. Researchers believe this residue could be evidence that beer may have been brewed for a funeral 13,000 years ago. (article)
