
October Meeting: Due to TAG, our next social meet-up/cavort planning meeting will be the second Thursday in October. The location is TBD.

CAVING IN THE NEWS

Roman Swords Discovered in Dead Sea Cave 1,900 Years after Jewish Rebellion: Israeli archeologists announced Wednesday the discovery of four extremely rare and well-preserved Roman swords in a small hidden cave in an area of isolated cliffs overlooking the Dead Sea. The archaeologists initially visited the cave to inspect a stalactite with an ancient fragmentary ink inscription in Hebrew from the time of the First Temple. During the trip, one of the archaeologists noticed a well-preserved pilum and nearby were pieces of worked wood that turned out to be the swords' scabbards. SCCi Plans To Purchase Sinkhole Cave in Marion County, TN: In 1975, a group of Chattanooga cavers discovered a sinkhole In Marion County, TN. Cavers continued to enjoy the pit for about 20 years, but it was eventually closed to cavers in 1994; the cave is now up for sale and the SCCi hopes to purchase it and reopen to responsible recreation and continued preservation.
