CAVING IN THE NEWS

In Arunachal, Trekkers Find Cave Used by Allied Forces as Transit Camp During WWII: Tagit Sorang's team of 27 was scaling the hills of the frontier state's Tirap district when it came across a stone cave near the Arunachal-Myanmar border. According to the locals, Allied Forces used the cave as a transit camp to resist Japanese soldiers making their way from Burma (now Myanmar) to vast parts of North-East Frontier Agency (now Arunachal Pradesh).
