Volunteer Efforts Remove Litter and Invasives from Charles B Henson Preserve: Over 40 volunteers joined together to clean Charles B Henson Preserve in Georgia. Volunteers gathered trash, cleared out invasive plants, and redirected water in a drainage ditch. Over 500 hours of work, valued at \$10,000 of labor, was put into cleaning the preserve. Meet the Northern Cavefish: 2024 USA Cave Animal of the Year: The Northern Cavefish belongs to the family

Amblyopsidae, which includes five other cavefish species endemic to the Ozarks and Interior Low Plateau karst regions in the central and eastern United States. The Amblyopsidae has long intrigued biologists and they are an important model system for studies of cave adaptation. Northern Cavefish live in subterranean aquatic habitats including deep pools and shoals in cave streams, smaller tributaries, and rimstone pools. Cavefishes act as top predators in many cave systems. Protecting cavefishes and their groundwater habitats is crucial for not only preserving subterranean biodiversity but for safeguarding an important resource that we, as humans, are becoming increasingly reliant upon.
