NSS Webinar Series-A Review of Knot Testing

Strength: The strength of rigging knots is a much debated and argued subject, and yet data and evidence are rarely used to discuss life safety knot strengths. A literature review and meta-analysis of knot strength research (114 studies) was performed and the results show just how strong knots are both in relationship to each other and their absolute strengths in various materials.

Tom Evans will be discussing facts and debunking myths during this webinar. Tom has been a vertical caver for a decade, and has been trained in both above and below ground rope rescue. He is an NCRC instructor and cofounded the nonprofit SAR3, dedicated to providing research and teaching in support of rescue and sport rigging. Its results are published by the International Technical Rescue Symposium. Through his work, Tom is constantly immersed in the science and practice of rigging. (article)
