Evidence of Nine Neanderthals Found in Italian Cave: The fossil remains of nine Neanderthal men have been found in Guattari Cave in San Felice Circeo, Italy. Eight of the fossils date between 50,000 and 68,000 years old and the ninth fossil could be 90,000 to 100,000 years old. [\(article\)](#)
