Vertical Training Commission: In August 2021, the NSS Board of Governors (BOG) approved the creation of a Vertical Training Transition Committee, which they charged with drafting the Vertical Training Commission (VTC) charter. The purpose of the VTC is to create a training curriculum to help interested individuals obtain competency in vertical caving techniques, develop and maintain a vertical training program, and to train competent, safe, and active vertical trainers to be proficient in teaching VTC educational materials. 6,000-Year-Old Skull Found in Cave in Taiwan Possibly Confirms Legend of Indigenous Tribe: A team of researchers with members from Australia, Japan, Taiwan and Vietnam found 6,000-year-old skull and femur bones in a cave in a mountainous part of Taiwan that might prove the existence of an ancient Indigenous tribe. There have been stories of this Indigenous tribe that once lived in mountainous parts of the island, but until now, there has been no physical evidence of them. (article)
